



Scheme Fees 2023

Welsh Government Quarantine Unit Scheme

The cost of certification is £172.80 (including £28.80 VAT) for one QU or £244.80 (Including £40.80 VAT) for two, provided that the assessment of both QUs is undertaken at the same time. If the QU assessment can be undertaken by QWFC at the same time as another assessment then there will be a reduction of 10%. Payment can be made by cheque, direct debit or credit card. If you are a member of the FAWL or Welsh Organic Scheme and have an active direct debit mandate in place, you may wish to use that facility to pay.

Scheme fees will be debited from your account on or after the 28th of the month in which you join and every eighteen months thereafter if you are paying by direct debit

Should an applicant prefer not to submit a direct debit mandate, we reserve the right to charge higher fees to cover the extra administration costs of collecting subscriptions by cheque.

If payment is not made by the due date, your certificate will be suspended. If no payment is received within three months, certification will be withdrawn and should you wish to re-apply you will have to do so as a new applicant.
